Reasonable Attendance Adjustment Arrangement

Faculty are responsible for establishing attendance requirements for their classes, and ensuring they are clearly outlined per the syllabus at the beginning of each semester. All students, regardless of disability, are responsible for fulfilling the essential requirements of courses/programs/degrees, including attendance expectations. No academic standards, educational experiences/outcomes should be waived, compromised or lowered. However, the episodic nature and severity of some disabilities may impact a student's ability to fulfill typical attendance requirements.

A student eligible for Reasonable Attendance Adjustments will have this indicated on their ODR Accommodation Plan. Faculty should closely examine essential course requirements, and may consult with ODR to determine reasonable course specific adjustments.
